

## KAF iCASH FUND (KiCF)

The fund's objective is to provide investors with liquidity while providing reasonable returns by investing its assets in Islamic deposits.

### ASSET ALLOCATION

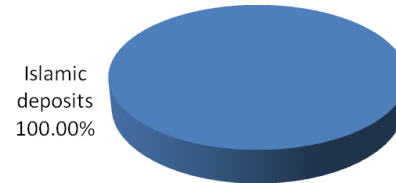
The fund's portfolio will be structured as follows:

- 90% to 100% of Net Asset Value (NAV)  
Investments in Islamic deposits placed with financial institutions which have a remaining maturity period of not more than 365 days.
- Up to 10% of NAV  
Investments in Islamic deposits placed with financial institutions which have a remaining maturity period of more than 365 days but fewer than 732 days.

Distribution policy	Subject to the availability of income, distributions will be made on a monthly basis.

### ASSET ALLOCATION\* AS AT 31 MARCH 2026



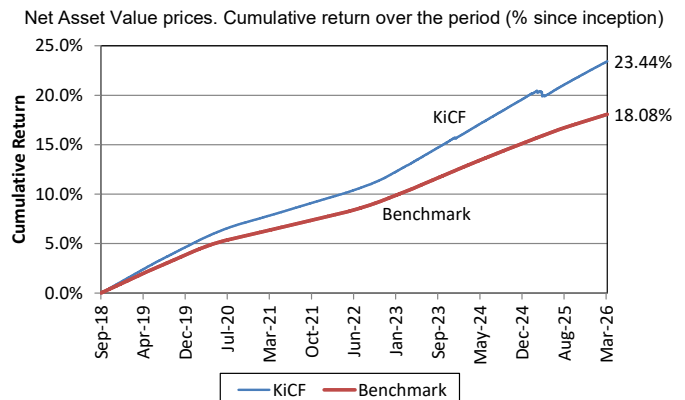
